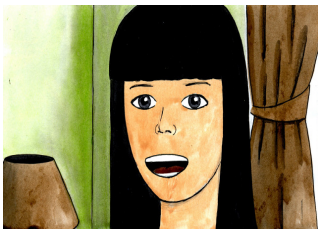


Handout 12.2

Word	Definition
Bystander	A person who is present when something happens but does not take part.
Bully	A person who uses their strength to influence, harm or frighten someone.
Challenging	To say something to someone about something that you disagree with.
Supportive	Providing help or see things from another person's point of view.
Encouraging	Giving someone support or confidence.
Helpful	Making it <u>easier</u> or <u>possible</u> for someone to do something by <u>offering</u> them your support.
Ignore	Refuse to take notice of someone or something.
Intervene	Take part in something that might stop or change something happening.
Offensive	Causing someone to feel upset or annoyed.
Protective	Willing to keep someone safe from harm or injury.
Respectful	Considerate of the feelings, wishes or rights of others.
Safe	Protected from anger or risk.
Scared	Fearful or frightened of something or someone.
Silence	To not mention or discuss something.
Stand by	To be there whilst something bad is happening but fail to do anything to stop it.
